Updates from October Meeting

- Medicaid fiscal accountability proposed rule
 - Requires reporting of amounts of supplemental payments to hospitals and sources of non-federal share
 - Strengthens requirement to recover DSH overpayments
 - Process changes for publishing DSH allotments
- Updates to tables in previous reports
 - Characteristics of DSH hospitals
 - Hospital margins
 - State-level data
